



## Healthcare Visitation Regulations

Please read and follow the rules listed below. If you are observed not following these regulations, you will be asked to leave for the safety of our residents and staff.

- **Daily Visitation Hours:**
  - **8:30-11:30am**
  - **1:00-5:00pm**
  - **6:30-9:00pm \*\*Must arrive and screen in between 6:30-6:50pm. The receptionist leaves at 7pm and you will not be able to enter after that.**
  - **End of life visitation is not limited and may extend through the night.**
- Screening:
  - Check your temperature and complete the screening form at the front desk.
  - You must wear a new surgical facemask, provided by Bethany.
  - Perform hand hygiene – use a generous amount of hand sanitizer and rub all parts of your hands vigorously.
  - Wear mask and keep the mask over the nose and mouth **at all times**. Do not pull the mask down to talk. If you touch the mask, you must wash your hands or use hand sanitizer. If you are observed with your mask down or off, you will be asked to leave.
- Indoor Visitation:
  - 2 visitors allowed at a time. There is no limit on the number of visits per day!
  - No food or drinks during visitation.
  - Please go directly to and from your loved one's room. Do not linger in the hallways or common areas. Please use hand sanitizer before leaving the room.
  - Visitation should occur in the resident's room. Outdoor visitation is encouraged, including on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor patio if room allows.
- Children:
  - Children who are able to properly adhere to the infection control guidelines listed above, including proper wearing of facemask, are allowed to visit. If unable, children may visit outdoors.
- Special Requests/Outings:
  - Car rides, outdoor parks, and small outdoor gatherings are allowed.
  - We ask that the resident and visitor wear their facemasks during visits in and out of the building.
  - Resident should use hand sanitizer immediately upon return to the facility.

If needed, the nurse can contact Shannon. We can discuss the circumstances and whether or not quarantine or special testing is needed.
